**NOTIFICATION**

G.S.R.----In exercise of the powers conferred by .....and in suppression of the .....expect as respect things done or committed to be done before such suppression, the central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Para-Medical Group “C” combatised post in Para Medical Cadre in the.....in the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement** - (i) These rules may be called the Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles Combatised Para Medical Cadre Group “C” Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application** - These rules shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and level in the Pay Matrix** - The number of said posts, its classification, and the level in Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be specified in column (5) to (13) of the Schedule.

5. **Disqualifications---No person,**

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said cadre:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Liability to serve** - Any person appointed to any post under these rules shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad.

7. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.

8. **Saving-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.
